Item No. 63 October 12, 2018 implementation/execution of the order dated 20<sup>th</sup> August, 2018, has not yet taken place nor the Apex Committee has started functioning under which other Committees have to work, by which the implementation of Solid Waste Management Rules is to be done upto the grass root level.

Therefore, we issue Notice to the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, MoEF & CC and CPCB. We direct the Joint Secretary, Swacha Bharat, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs to remain present on the next date of hearing, after obtaining full instructions with regard to reasons as to why the order of the Tribunal have not been executed so far and the Apex Committee has not started functioning. The aforesaid Joint Secretary shall file a personal affidavit giving out the details in response to the aforesaid facts on the next date of hearing.
